Getting there by Car

Follow the A14 until you are near to Ipswich, then join the A12 signposted to Colchester and London. Follow the A12 for roughly 12 miles, and then take the exit signposted to Colchester and Harwich (A120). Turn left at the roundabout and join the A120 signposted Harwich.

The A120 will take you directly to Harwich Old Town, with exits to the Harwich International Port and to Dovercourt.

From the M25, follow the A12 until you are near to Colchester. Pass exits to Colchester West and to Colchester Central. Take the next exit, marked Harwich (A120). The A120 will take you directly to Harwich Old Town, with exits to the International Port.

Car parking is available at Harwich International Port for long and short term stay.

The car park machines accept payment by cash or credit card. Please note there is a lost ticket charge of £85. Whilst every effort is made to ensure the car park is safe and secure vehicles are left at owner's risk.

Getting there by Train

National Express East Anglia trains take you direct to Harwich International station which is located next to the terminal building from where you can board your Stena Line ferry to Holland.

To find which National Express East Anglia train you should be on to get to the port on time, have a look at the timetable or visit www.nationalexpresseastanglia.com for a full list of stations and train departure times.
