Getting there by Car

Holyhead Port is located on Anglesey in North Wales. The port is conveniently situated at the end of the A55 dual carriageway. It is approximately 1 hour and 40 minutes from Chester, 2 hours from Liverpool, 2 hours and 20 minutes from Manchester and 3 hours and 15 minutes from Birmingham when travelling by car. A Travelodge can be found in Holyhead town and there are hotels and supermarkets close by.

Large long stay car park available with a park and ride service taking customers to Terminal 1.

Payment may be made by cash or credit card using the card machine in the car park.

Leave the M6 at junction 16 signposted Chester. Continue onward onto the A51 then merge onto the A55 sign posted North Wales. Continue onward onto the A55 entering Holyhead

Check-In Times

Accompanied Units:

40 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time

Unaccompanied Units:

60 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.

Hazardous Unaccompanied:

120 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.

Hazardous Accompanied:

60 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.

When carrying horses and equine please check in 1 hour before the sailing.

Parking

Storage facilities

Vehicles can normally be left on the quayside for up to 48 hours. However, vehicles that are on hand longer than this period may be subject to standage charges. Vehicles not intended for shipment are not permitted in the port.

Demurrage/Standage charges

Charges for trailers or other equipment that remains on the quayside for a prolonged period of time may be charged parking/standage charges.
