### **Getting there by Car**

Dun Laoghaire Port is located 12.9 Km (8 miles) south of Dublin city centre. Extensive signage on all main roads leading to the port gives clear directions.

There are 450 pay and display car parking spaces in and around the ferry terminal. Parking is operated by the Dun Laoghaire Harbour Company, [www.dlharbour.ie](http://www.dlharbour.ie) and the charges below apply. There are several Park and Display machines located around the terminal which take coin and notes. Machines in the underground car park take credit cards and payment can also be made at the Harbour Police desk located in the concourse.

- 12 hours – €5.00
- 24 hours – €10.00
- Weekly – €50.00

### Getting there by Car

Dublin Area Rapid Transport (DART) trains run approximately every twenty minutes through Dun Laoghaire. Dun Laoghaire station is also served by mainline trains. Further details of timetables and fares are available on [www.irishrail.ie](http://www.irishrail.ie). The station is located directly across the road from the ferry terminal.

### Check-in Times – Passenger/Private Travel

We strongly recommend you check-in at least one hour before departure.

Travelling Dun Laoghaire - Holyhead, CHECK-IN WILL CLOSE 30 minutes before departure.

Those with Premium or Cabin bookings are advised to arrive 60 minutes prior to departure to avail of express boarding.

### Foot passengers travelling with pets:

On all our vessels on this route, foot passengers may bring small pets in a pet traveller's case, but they will be placed on the car deck for the duration of the journey, as no animals are permitted in the Passenger areas onboard.

Guide, hearing, autism and other types of registered assistance dogs are welcome in the Passenger Lounge at both the port and onboard all of our vessels.

### **Check-in Times**

#### **Accompanied Units:**

40 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.

#### **Hazardous Accompanied:**

90 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.

The port only handles accompanied traffic and therefore is unable to store vehicles beyond normal waiting times for vessel departures. Vehicles on hand longer than this period may be subject to standage / parking charges.
