### Getting there by Car

#### Car Parking

There is a long stay car park with around 60 spaces located 150 metres from the main terminal building and a short term car park directly opposite with several large spaces for disabled badge holders.

The car park is pay and display, the machines accept sterling coin and credit cards.

- 24 hours – £7.00
- Weekly – £35.00

### Getting there by Train

**Arriva Trains Wales** operate 7 trains daily to and from Fishguard Harbour and have special trains to connect with the arrival and departures of the Stena Line Superferry Stena Europe that operates to/from Rosslare.

Depart Fishguard Harbour at: 01:50\*, 06:53, 08:04, 09:56, 13:50\*, 19:00 & 20:50hrs and trains arriving in Fishguard are: 06:44, 09:46, 13:35\*, 18:29, 20:30 & 01:29\*.

### Check-in Time Passenger/ Private Travel

We strongly recommend you check-in at least one hour before departure.

Travelling Fishguard-Rosslare, CHECK-IN WILL CLOSE 30 minutes before departure.

Those with Premium or Cabin bookings are advised to arrive 60 minutes prior to departure to avail of express boarding.

### Foot passengers travelling with pets:

Foot passengers may bring small pets in a pet traveller's case, but they will be placed on the car deck for the duration of the journey, as no animals are permitted in the passenger areas onboard.

Guide, hearing, autism and other types of registered assistance dogs are welcome in the Passenger Lounge at both the port and onboard all of our vessels.

### **Directions**

For Fishguard Harbour use the M5 for North/South travel which connects with the M4, this runs from East to West.

The A40 London to Fishguard Trunk Road through Wales connects Fishguard to the M4. It is a route of European importance and forms part of the E30 highway from Cork to Moscow.

Travelling from north Wales use the A487 (If the vehicle is over 13 metres they have a detour of approx 40 miles on the outskirts of Fishguard which routes them onto the A40; this is to avoid Lower Town, an accident black spot for long vehicles).

### Check-in Times

#### **Accompanied:**

40 minutes prior to scheduled departure time.

#### **Unaccompanied:**

60 minutes prior to scheduled departure time

#### **Hazardous Unaccompanied:**

120 minutes prior to scheduled departure time

#### **Hazardous Accompanied:**

60 minutes prior to scheduled departure time

**When carrying horses and equine please check-in 1 hour before the sailing.**

### Parking

#### Storage facilities

Vehicles can normally be left on the quayside for up to 48 hours. However, vehicles that are on hand longer than period may be subject to standage charges. Vehicles not intended for shipment are not permitted in the port.

#### Demurrage/Standage charges

Charges for trailers or other equipment that remains on the quayside for a prolonged period of time may be charged parking/standage charges
